Winter draindowns

You may be interested in a draindown system for holiday caravans which we have recently discovered. It comprises an air compressor permantently fitted in your boiler cupboard. It is connected to your incoming wate supply; to drain down the caravan, turn off the outside stop tap, start the compressor and then open one tap at a time through your caravan and finally flush the toilet to leave all water pipes and valves which are likely to freeze clear of water.

When you return to the caravan you just need to turn the stop tap back on to resume normal use.

Please contact John or Brian to discuss this option. The cost of supply and installation is around £500.
