As you can see from the floor plan the Maple has all the benefits of a much larger caravan and the space to fit it all in its 28 foot length by having only one bedroom.

Work at Bank House



John and Hannah were busy during lockdown. Hannah has stripped the walls and repointed the stonework using lime mortar. John has made supporting beams from an oak tree that was felled on the park, and has replaced the floor with one made from an old squash court. They have also replaced the ceiling, and the floor in the bedroom above.

Get ready for winter!

Winter draindown (prices held from 2018) costs £140 less a discount of £40 if you agree to the work being done in the week commencing 30th November. Call Brian on 01568 750665 to book the date and pay.

You should note that our drain down service comes with our guarantee so that if there is any frost damage after we have completed our work and before we reconnect you to the water supply we will carry out any repair entirely at our cost.

If you wish to use your caravan into the colder months remember the Compass insurance will cover any frost damage providing you have taken the precaution of turning off the outside stopcock and then flushing the toilets and opening all internal taps. This rule does not apply during January and February when the park is closed, so you do need a full drain down for these months.

If you do it yourself, please don't use commercial antifreeze as it damages the sewage treatment plant. (For the same reason you shouldn't use bleach for cleaning.) Next spring please call us about a week before you plan to use your caravan and we will reconnect you.

If you would like an automatic floë 868 system fitted, this can be arranged for £300. This would pay for itself in three years, and for a nominal cost it can be moved to a new caravan if you decide to upgrade.
