Dos and don'ts – to make your stay with us more comfortable

GAS & ELECTRICITY

If your gas or electricity supply fails during your stay please notify us at reception immediately. We always try to be available from 8am to 10am and from 5pm to 7pm. Please remember to turn off the fire(s)/central heating whenever you leave the caravan.

DOGS

If you have brought a dog with you on holiday please note the following:

- Always keep your dog under control and on a lead whilst on or near the park.
- Always clear up your dog's mess which may be disposed of in the park rubbish bins.
- You may walk your dog along the woodland walk at the top of the park.
- Please don't leave your dog unattended in your caravan.

BEDDING

To help us on changeover day it would be helpful if you would strip all duvet covers, pillow cases and sheets from beds you have used.

LAUNDRY

The laundry is mainly used for our own purposes and is not coin operated. However, if you would like to use it during your stay this can be arranged. Please ask at reception for details.

EQUIPMENT

To help us maintain equipment in good condition, please report any breakages, losses or failures in your caravan.

We don't provide dining table place mats. If you can hold hot plates or dishes in your hand, they will not damage the table.

RUBBISH DISPOSAL

Please dispose of rubbish in the bins located near reception. (See separate sheet on recycling.)

DRIVING

Remember to drive carefully along the unclassified single lane roads and look out for oncoming tractors, horses, sheep and walkers!

On the park, do not drive on the grass - please stay on the tarmac roads at all times.

KEYS

On the day of your departure please return your caravan keys to reception.

Health and Safety

We are committed to the highest possible standards to care for the health and safety of all park users. Please note the following.

ROADS

- The roads on the park are shared by motor vehicles and pedestrians so take care at all times.
- Only qualified drivers with a full licence may drive motor vehicles anywhere on the park.
- Speeds on the park should not exceed 10mph.
- The park roads should not be used for roller skates, scooters, bicycles etc.
- Do not drive on the grass stay on the tarmac roads at all times.

OFF ROAD

The park is set on a steep hillside with areas of steep slopes near to road edges and mown areas. Pedestrians and drivers should take care at all times to be aware of and keep away from steep drops.

AFTER DARK

We don't have street lights because many of our customers enjoy looking at the night sky. Torches are available at the house for a refundable deposit of $\pounds 5$.

FIRE

All caravans are equipped with a fire extinguisher and there are fire points at strategic positions round the park. For your safety you should note the fire exits from your caravan and the location of fire extinguishers. For emergencies the telephone at reception is available at all times.

MEDICAL

There is a small community hospital in Tenbury Wells, WR15 8AP (01584 810643) and a doctor may be contacted via the hospital or direct on 01584 810343, or in Bromyard on 01885 483412. Serious conditions should be referred directly to Worcester Royal Hospital, Charles Hastings Way, Worcester WR5 1JG, telephone 01905 763333.

TELEPHONE

There is an emergency telephone at reception.

BARBECUES

If you use a barbecue during your stay please note the following advice:

- Do not use a barbecue on the timber deck.
- Do not light a barbecue near to any combustible material, eg gas bottles or timber structures.
- Do not take a barbecue indoors under any circumstances.
- Only dispose of the spent barbecue once it is cold.

VERMIN

Please don't leave food scraps outside for the wildlife as this may encourage vermin.

SMOKE ALARMS AND CO2 ALARMS

The alarms in your caravan are checked weekly. If you have any concerns or a battery needs replacing please call reception.

Out and about – things to see and do

SHOPS

The nearest food shops are in Bromyard or Tenbury Wells. The Co-op in Bromyard is open from 8am to 10pm, Monday to Friday, from 8am to 8pm on Saturday and from 10am to 4pm on Sunday. Turn left on leaving the park and after two miles turn left on the B4214 towards Bromyard. The Co-op is on your left as you reach the edge of town. If you turn right to Tenbury Wells you'll find a Spar and Tesco. There is also a small Co-op on the edge of town.

There are bigger shopping centres in Worcester and Hereford, and interesting independent shops in Ledbury, Ludlow and Leominster.

HISTORIC HEREFORD and ROYALIST WORCESTER

The historic cities of Hereford and Worcester are both about half an hour's drive away. In **Hereford** Cathedral you'll find the famous Mappa Mundi (left) and the Chained Library. **Worcester** also has a magnificent catherdral and is famous for Royal Worcester Porcelain and Worcestershire sauce!

PRETTY MARKET TOWNS

Ludlow is a thriving medieval market town well known for food and an architectural gem. Ludlow Castle was started in 1086 and has been an important part of Ludlow for the many centuries since. The Feathers Hotel (right) is known as "the handsomest inn, in the world".

Visit **Ledbury** to see the most photographed street in England (left). Ledbury was home to poet Elizabeth Barrett Browning, who spent her childhood at Hope End, and is also the birthplace of poet laureate John Masefield.

Leominster is a historic wool town with a variety of antique and curiosity shops and cafés. Leominster Priory displays the town's feared ducking stool.

BLACK AND WHITE VILLAGES

Follow the **Black and White Trail** through some of the most delightful villages in England. Information can be found at the Tourist Information Centre in Leominster.

LOCAL ATTRACTIONS

Visit **Ironbridge** with its famous iron bridge and its many industrial museums including the popular Blists Hill Museum.

The **West Midland Safari Park** with its four-mile self-drive safari is the home of the biggest pride of white lions in the UK, as well as the largest collection of white tigers and cheetah and the largest herd of hippo. Enjoy wild sea lion shows and fun animal encounters. Don't miss the dinosaurs!

Go back in time and enjoy a ride on a steam train at **Severn Valley Railway**, a full-size standard-gauge railway line, running regular, mainly steam-hauled, passenger trains between Kidderminster in Worcestershire and Bridgnorth in Shropshire, a distance of about sixteen miles.

NATIONAL TRUST

Nearby National Trust properties include **Croft Castle**, **Berrington Hall**, **Harvington Hall** and **Lower Brockhampton** (pictured right).
